The top 14 JROTC high schools from across Kentucky and Tennessee participated in the March 1st competition, which included seven physically and mentally demanding events. At the end, Henry Clay and Fort Knox High Schools were tied. It took a modified relay race to decide the winner.

Major William Larkin and SFC Brian Hunt credited their students' dedication to the JROTC program, noting that they trained two to three hours daily after school to prepare for the competition. "Our cadets wanted to show the other schools across Kentucky that we have the best Raider team in the state," Hunt said.

In addition to the First Place Overall win, the Raider team brought home trophies for 1st place Crossfit "O" Course, 2nd place Two-Mile Squad Run, and 2nd Place Rock Wall. The win was reported in "Stu's News" and in the "Devils Newsletter."

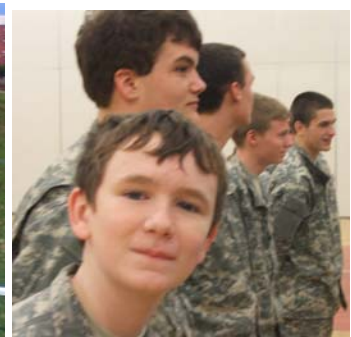
